Flood



So far (at least at the time of this writing), the CFPB has continued to avoid issuing any new or updated regulations, despite their public statements that they intend to do so. There are a number of new regulations coming at some point, but they are not yet here. This gives us an opportunity to continue to take a look at existing regulations to assure that they are not forgotten.

Flood violations continue to appear in the news, and flood questions continue to be a hot topic on our compliance hotline. As a result, we feel that it is time to return to this regulation to assure that you are following the rule explicitly, both to keep your name out of the news and avoiding writing a check for fines.

We will cover the latest information available as of the presentation date. There is a bill pending in Congress to extend the expiration of the program (currently scheduled for this fall), and to make changes to the area of private flood insurance programs. Given the acrimony of the current situation in Washington and the speed at which Congress accomplishes anything, we may or may not have news on this subject.

The subjects for the regulatory update will be determined by circumstances and releases from the various agencies. Unless there are major changes in the next few weeks, the majority of the presentation will be on the flood rule, as little is happening at the current time.
